8 Week Program

Week 01-03

The enrolled clinician will meet with the preceptor to review any questions, give instruction and educate on EVERY OASIS completed.

Week 03-06

Progress will be reviewed at the end of Week 3. If appropriate the clinician will begin to receive 1:1 focused instruction and education as follows: 100% of OASIS completed in Week 4, 75% in Week 5, and 50% in Week 6.

Week 07-08

Progress will be reviewed at the end of Week 6. If appropriate, HRP will begin to review submitted OASIS for accuracy and compliance as follows: 100% of OA-SIS completed in Week 7, and 50% in Week 8.



LIVE OASIS Refresher

6 Week Program

Week 01-02

Clinician meets with HRP preceptor for instruction on prerequisite modules and 5 full OASIS assessments and preceptor reviews 100% of OASIS assessments to identify deficiencies in Week 2.

Week 03

50% of OASIS completed will be completed with LIVE tutoring, and 50% of OASIS completed will be reviewed to track progress.

Week 04-06

100% of OASIS completed in Week 4 will be reviewed, 75% in Week 5, and 50% in Week 6
